Public Space Protection Order:

Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014
Section 59

London Borough of Camden Public Spaces Protection Order No. 1 of 2016

The London Borough of Camden ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act") hereby makes the following Order:-

CITATION, COMMENCEMENT AND DURATION

1. This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Camden Public Spaces Protection Order No. 1 of 2016 ("the Order")
2. The Order is made on .../.../2016 and shall have effect for a period of 3 years thereafter, unless extended, varied, or discharged by further order(s) under the Council's statutory powers.

STATUTORY CONDITIONS

3. The Council is satisfied that on reasonable grounds that the activity(s) outlined below when carried on in public place;
 - a. Has had a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those living in the locality; and
 - b. The effect, or likely effect of the activity;
 - i. Is, or is likely to be, persistent or continuing in nature
 - ii. Is, or is likely to be, unreasonable; and
 - iii. Justifies the restrictions imposed.
4. The Council is satisfied that it is reasonable to impose the restriction outlined below to reduce the detrimental effect and to reduce the risk of its continuance, occurrence or recurrence.

AREA TO WHICH THE ORDER APPLIES

5. The Order relates to the whole of the London Borough of Camden (the Restricted Area), with the exception of the Royal Parks, as per the map attached.

ACTIVITY PROHIBITED

6. Urination

RESTICTIONS

7. All persons are prohibited from urinating in any public place, including any park, open spaces, square, street, highway, court or passage, or on private property without the consent of the lawful owner, within the Restricted Area.

8. The restriction does not apply in relation to any public or private lavatory or urinal designed for such purpose.

PENALTY

9. Any person who, without reasonable excuse, fails to comply with this Order shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 (£1000) on the standard scale or may be issued with a fixed penalty notice in the amount of £100.
