I will work on collaborating with schools and educational institutions by partnering local schools and colleges to provide resources, mentorship programmes and internship opportunities that can help students gain valuable skills and experience.

Career guidance and counselling:

- Providing career guidance and counselling services to students and young adults can help them make informed decisions about their future and develop the necessary skills for success.
