Who can I see in CLDS?



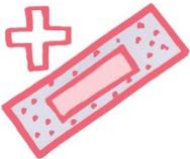
- a psychiatrist or psychologist

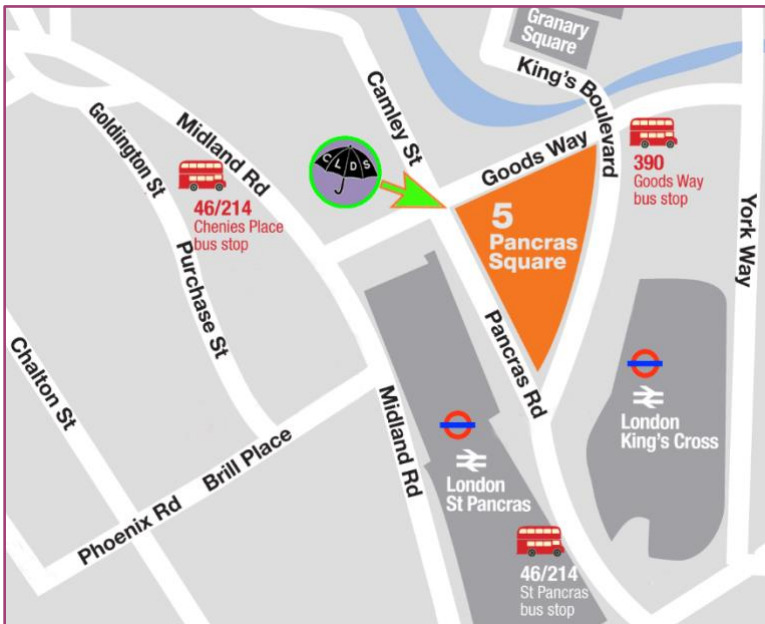

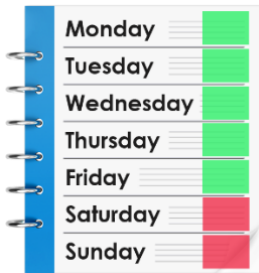
